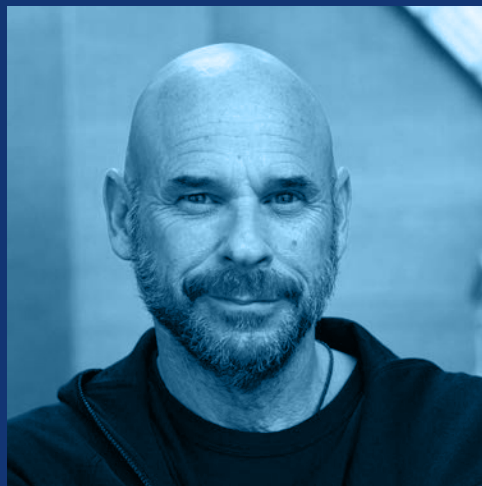

GREAT PARTNERSHIPS ARE KEY FOR WATER SUSTAINABILITY

The One Drop Foundation is committed to giving back locally and partnering with the best non-profit organizations in Southern Nevada who are addressing local water challenges. One Drop strives to raise awareness about water conservation, encourage innovation and grassroots involvement, and above all, to make a difference. The power of philanthropy is strongest when we work together to turn water into action.



- Every year, a portion of the proceeds from Las Vegas events are used to finance and support water conservation, technology and innovation, and education efforts in Southern Nevada.
- The One Drop Foundation has donated over \$1.5 million to excellent partner organizations in the region, such as Springs Preserve, Desert Research Institute, DISCOVERY Children’s Museum and WaterStart.
- This year alone, One Drop’s fundraising events will generate over \$200,000 in contributions to local initiatives.



WATER CHALLENGES AND LOCAL SUSTAINABILITY EFFORTS IN NEVADA

Lake Mead water levels have dropped about 170 feet over the past two decades.

- Southern Nevada will invest nearly \$2.5 billion over the next 30 years to become more drought-resilient through efforts such as conservation and infrastructure.

In 2022 and 2023, the U.S. Government reduced Southern Nevada’s water allocation by over 8 billion gallons.

- Thanks to conservation initiatives, Southern Nevada residents are using 100 gallons less per person each day than they did 20 years ago and Colorado River water use is on track to fall to its lowest point in 30 years.

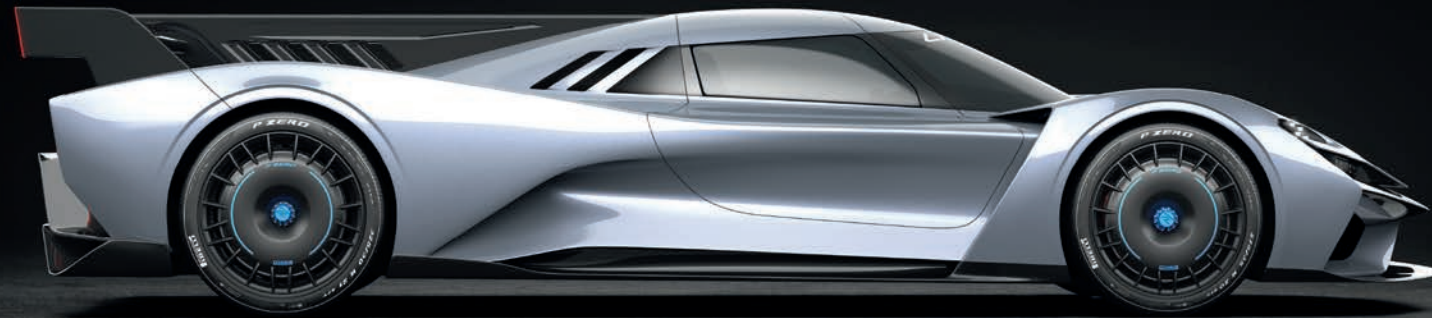

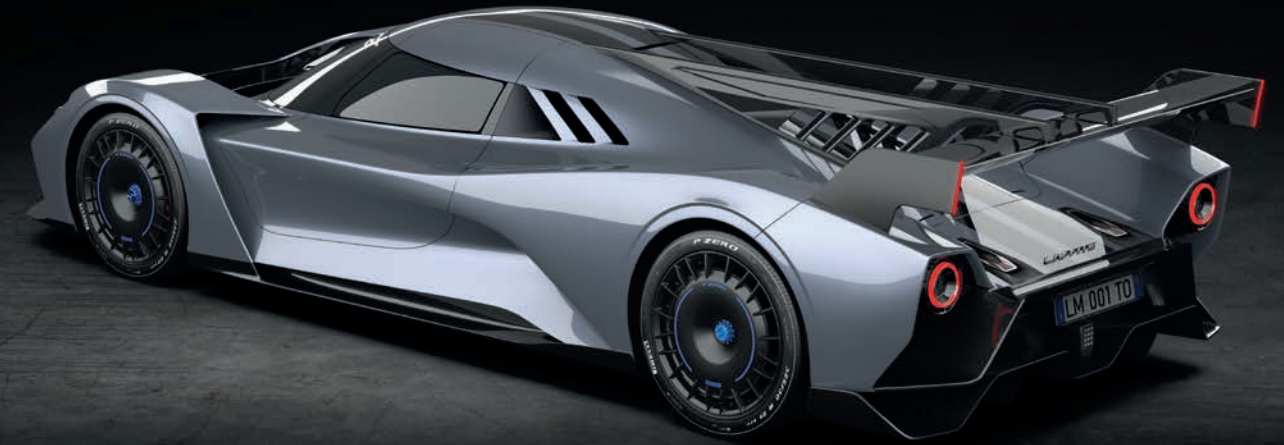

WORDS YOU WILL HEAR TONIGHT

ACID, ACIDITY ON THE NOSE: mouthwatering and refreshing (tartaric), or like raw cooking apples (malic).

AFTER-TASTE: the internal 'bouquet' after a wine has been drunk; unpleasant if the wine is strongly flavoured and in poor condition; but also, the hallmark of a great wine.

AROMA: is part of the smell of wine derived from the grape, as opposed to bouquet (qv), which is derived from development of the wine itself.

ASTRINGENT: a dry, mouth-puckering effect caused by a high tannin content (often accompanied by a high degree of acidity); may soften as the wine matures.

BODY: the weight of wine in the mouth due to its alcohol content, extract, and other physical components. These factors stem from the quality of the vintage and geographical origin.

COARSE: rough, lacking breeding; not to be confused with the rough rawness of immature wine.

DEPTH: richness and subtlety with seeming 'layers' of flavor, all interlocked.

FINISH: the end taste; a wine cannot be considered well-balanced without a good finish, which means a firm, crisp and distinctive end; a poor finish will be watery, the flavour tailing off.

FOXY: the distinctive, earthy of some native American vine species, known wild or 'fox' grapes.

LUSCIOUS: soft, sweet, fat, fruity and ripe, with all these qualities in balance.

MELLOW: soft, limpid and no rough edges; a characteristic normally associated with maturity.

NUANCE: having components reminiscent of specific smells, for example almonds or struck flint.

PERFUME: agreeable, scented quality of bouquet.

PENETRATING: a powerful, with almost a physical effect on the nostrils.

RICH: self-explanatory; a full ensemble of fruit, flavour, alcohol and extract.

SILKY: firm yet distinctly soft texture on the palate; characteristic of fine dessert wines and Pomerols.

SUAVE: soft, supple and harmonious.

TANNIN: an essential preservative derived from grape skins during fermentation; broken down in the bottle, becoming part of the deposit or crust that is left. Feels dry on the roof of the mouth, and sometimes imparts a 'dusty cellar' smell.

VELVETY: silky and smooth but implying opulence.

WELL-BALANCED: a satisfactory blend of physical components: fruit, acid, tannin, alcohol, etc.

The AALTO project was founded in 1999 in the prestigious winemaking region of Ribera del Duero (Spain) by Mariano García and Javier Zaccagnini. The foundational aim was to make a wine that shows a different personality, of high quality and being a faithful reflection of distinct locations, blending them at the end of the ageing process to obtain balance and complexity.

The winery currently controls 130 hectares of old vines of Tempranillo located in 9 different locations that are individually and manually harvested. This separation is maintained during the vinification process and ageing in barrels. The production of our wines is carried out by using gravity which means a qualitative leap respecting the exceptional quality and all the nuances of the Tempranillo variety during all the vinification process.





Originally established in Paris in 1973 by Steven Spurrier, the Academie du Vin was France's first private wine school teaching wine appreciation to ex-patriate British and Americans living in the city. The location of the school was adjacent to Steven Spurrier's famous wine store, the Caves de la Madeleine, and designed inside a former locksmith shop.

The Academie du Vin quickly rose to fame in wine enthusiast circles through its association with the 1976 Judgement of Paris – a blind tasting which brought recognition to California wines and changed the wine world forever.

With Steven's extensive training and experience in the UK wine trade, he was instrumental in creating an educational wine phenomenon that transformed enthusiast's approach to wine; by perfectly blending enjoyment and technical expertise.

TASTING

The name Lafite comes from the Gascon language term “la hite”, which means “hillock”. There were probably already vineyards on the property at the time when the Ségur family organised the vineyard in the 17th century, and Lafite began to earn its reputation as a great winemaking estate.

The techniques are traditional, based on strict control of yields, manual harvests, and numerous tasks that are carried out by hand all through the year. Little or no chemical fertilizers are used, and careful use of organic fertilizers allow the vines to reach an advanced age, they are generally pulled out (with a heavy heart) when they reach 80 years old

The vineyard consists of three main areas: the hillsides around the Château, the adjacent Carruades plateau to the west, and 4.5 hectares in neighbouring Saint-Estèphe. The vineyard covers 112 hectares and is well-drained and well-exposed, with soil made up of fine deep gravel, mixed with aeolian sand on a subsoil of tertiary limestone. It is well-drained and well-exposed to the sun.

In 126 years of distillation, they became the family that transformed Grappa from what was perceived as a simple low-quality product to fight off hunger and cold to a spirit that represents Italian excellence all over the world. This process known as the Grappa Revolution, started with the mission of maintaining the absolute quality in the distillation process, and finalized the 1st December 1973 with the creation of the first single varietal Grappa: the Monovitigno® Nonino. This date signed a turning point for the whole Grappa category, Grappa from being a fiery liquor made distilling pomace all mixed without any distinction, turned into the spirit that captures the soul, the essence of the grape and serves it in the glass. Today Nonino Distillery is still a family run company that made of craft distillation, and respect of the quality of raw material, their life mission. In fact, not only they are the only grappa distillery that declares on their label "100% distilled with artisanal method", but also their commitment to grappa made them built a unique distillery in the world with 66 artisanal potstills. The reason beyond having much more than the average 12 potstills the other Italian distilleries have is that they are completely against the common practice in the industry of stocking the pomace up to 8 months per year. Instead, to distill only fresh pomace pressed the very same day, they distill 24 hours per day (even at night) but maximum 9 weeks per year, exactly in combination with the harvest.

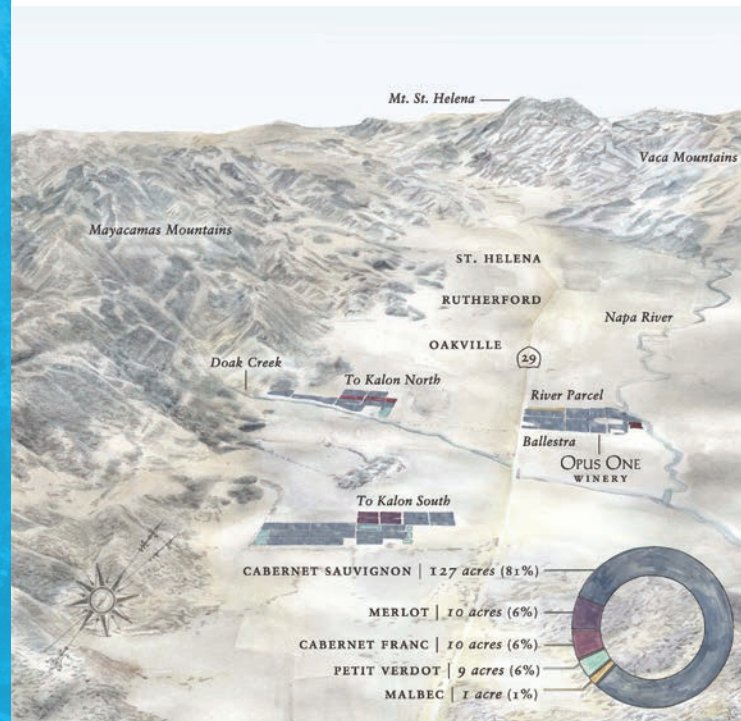

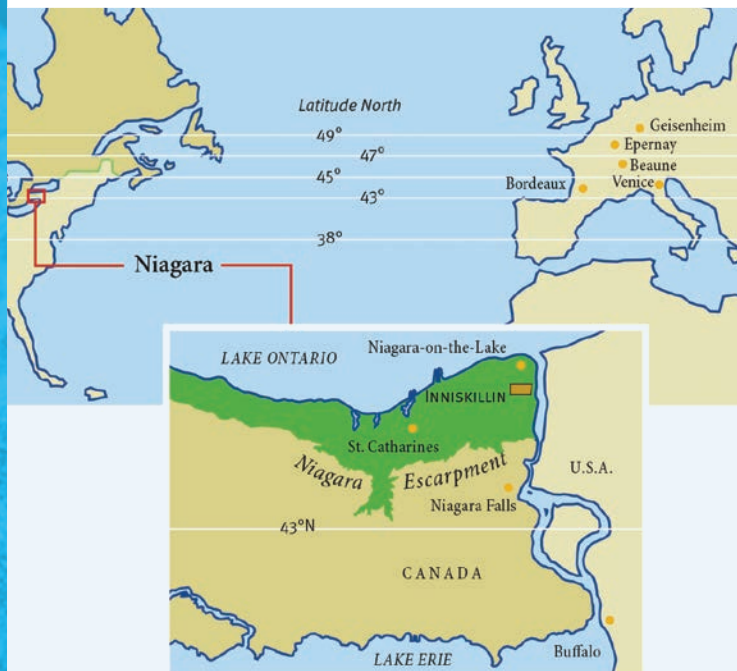

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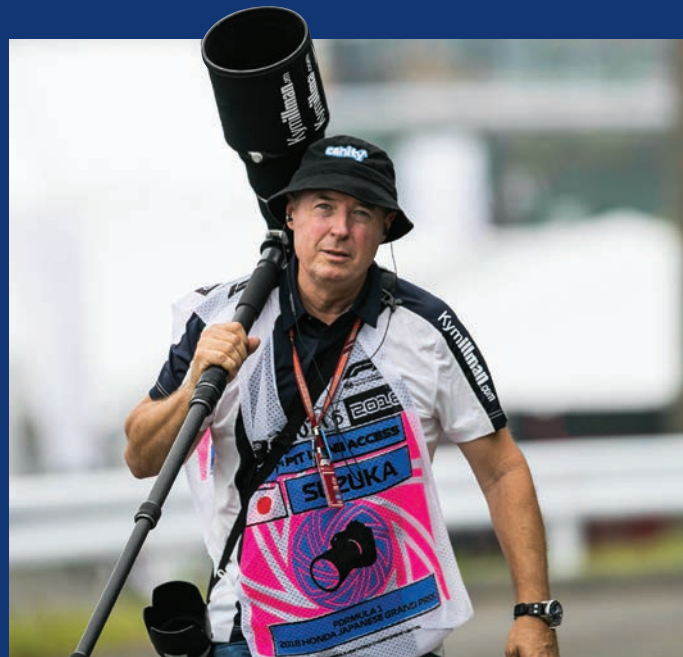
